As I promised in the announcements made after Mass last week, here is the address to send your Diocesan pledges to:

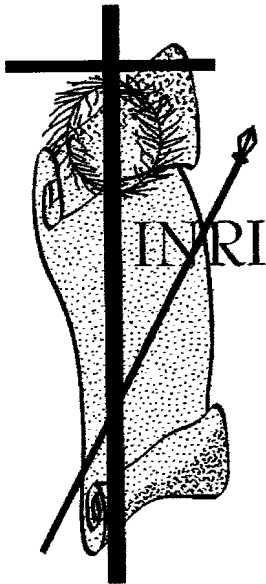
